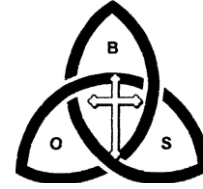
St Mary's Church Oakley on Saturday July 14th at 19.30. The Joyful Company of Singers will be performing a programme of English, acapella ,choral music.
