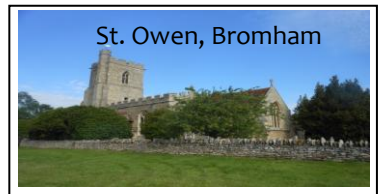

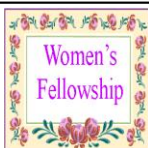

All visitors welcome whether they merely wish to ascend the tower, watch the ringing take place or try their hand, under STRICT supervision, at the end of one of the ropes.
