Reflection

St John brings us to the family bereavement. Jesus arrives at a scene of grief {seemingly too late}. It raises Lazarus four days after he had died. Jesus breaks old boundaries - the patterns of life and death. Death is no longer the end. God in Jesus brings life from death, joy out of sorrow. The sisters had faith that Jesus could have prevented Lazarus dying if he had been there earlier, but their faith never imagined this miracle. This prefigures Jesus' own death and resurrection. Lazarus becomes a sign, a witness to God's glory.

Jesus our Lord, send us to care and serve;
